On Resurrection Sunday we are planning on baptizing in two of our worship services and celebrating in all three that the tomb is EMPTY! What a great way to start off the month. Great things are in store for April.

In thinking about this week in history, Passion Week, I am reminded that those who had spent the most time with Jesus still didn't understand all that was taking place. Jesus had shared with them concerning his departure in death and resurrection but they were still holding on to their hopes of an earthly king. The crowd that gathered on Palm Sunday began to say, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord." They thought they were involved in the grass roots movement of reclaiming Jewish power from the Romans. When Jesus didn't demand they rise up and fight, they began to guestion Jesus' purpose. When Jesus talked about serving instead of ruling, they were confused.

On Tuesday of Passion Week, Jesus debated the Sadducees, the Pharisees, the Herodians, and the Chief Priests before continuing to teach His disciples about what is truly important in the Kingdom of Heaven. In Matthew 25 Jesus teaches about the sheep and the goats. Those who minister to the least of these are the ones who minister to Christ. Those who neglect those in need are also those who neglect Christ. The whole world will be gathered and separated.

It is intending that both those who inherit eternal life and those who go away into eternal punishment are surprised by the standards with which they were judged. What they did for others mattered more than what they did for self. For the sheep, they ministered and served the hungry, the thirsty, they stranger, the unclothed, the sick and the prisoner. Out of the goodness that God had placed within their heart, they served others. For the goats, they didn't see Christ in the hungry, thirsty, stranger, unclothed, sick or prisoner and therefore missed serving Christ.

Jeff Foxworthy in an interview with an area pastor shared, "My life is the best when I am not the most important thing in it." Jesus thought of others, even when they didn't understand. He comforted others when He needed comfort.

Instead of asking the question of what will we do with our life, a better question would be; how will we use our life. It is not about what we make of ourselves, but what we make of others. Jesus is abundantly clear that we are to make disciples of all nations. May this season of resurrection bring clarity to our efforts of serving one another. It is a joy to walk alongside each of you as we follow Jesus and God honors our service.

Continue to pray for our Long Range Planning Task Force as they share with us this month regarding our recent survey. Pray for their discernment and leadership as God leads them to lead us in preparation for what is to come.

Let me close this month with a comment by Franklin Graham given at his father, Billy Graham's funeral service speaking of his dad's invitation. "The world, with all of its political correctness, would want you to believe that there are many roads to God. It's just not true." Jesus is the way.


S.T.C.H. has not received their regular donations due to Hurricane Harvey, so let's help stock South Texas Children's Home with NON-PERISHABLE Food!


