I recall a collegiate softball game years ago where the batter hit a home room only to break her ankle while running the bases, a very uncommon occurrence. They could have forced her to forfeit her run or crawl around the bases in pain. Instead they garnered integrity and character and did what was right.

The wins and losses of a softball team only last for a season but the lessons learned in that season have the potential of leading us in life. Christians are encouraged in Scripture to bear one another's burdens, forgive each other, encourage each other, restore each other, and to stir one another to love and good deeds. There is something about "together" in Scripture. It is both the church's privilege and responsibility to stand together. Our world needs to see those who follow Christ working together.

There is coming a day when what divides us on earth will be of no importance. That does not mean that what we believe and hold with conviction is not necessary. But on that day, the only division will be what we did with Jesus. On that day, the lines that we have drawn will be erased and we will find ourselves in the circle of many who have common faith in Christ.

Until we are all gathered in His name, let us keep open the opportunity of crossing lines in order to present the one thing that matters most, the one thing that transforms us and our world, a relationship with Jesus Christ. In a fallen world, we see the destruction that takes place naturally as well as what we help to destroy. In that same fallen world, we can join God in His activity to make a difference. Not everybody recognizes the Court that sits above the Supreme Court, but for those that do, we answer to the highest authority.

Our focus is still Jesus and because of that, Trinity Baptist Church is in good hands moving in the right direction. Pray for our nation. Pray for our community. Pray for our church. Good things are in store even in light of the disharmony that is so prevalent.
