Best of all: if you sign up for camp during our VIP registration period, you get perks! Keep your eyes open for more details on perks as they're announced this week.



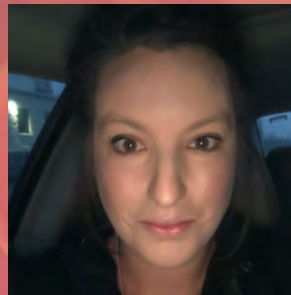

Mexico Mission Trip By Michael Derry

On Sunday, December 19, 2021 six members of Trinity Baptist Church (Bob & Patty Davis, Michael & Kerri Derry, and Boyd & Julie Robinson) left on a five-day mission trip to the area of San Miguel De Allene, Mexico. The group assisted full time missionaries Ben and Susie Argil (BrillaLife Ministries) for three days.

While most of the first and last days were spent traveling, the middle three days in Mexico, were very impactful and filled with God's blessings.

Twenty-one couples attended a marriage conference at the BrillaLife Center and five participants gave their lives to Christ! Several others expressed their desire to know more about God. We praise God for working in the lives of families and drawing fathers and mothers to Himself!

Groceries were provided for a family in need. The family had experienced a tragic loss the week prior to our arrival. Two of their young adult sons were in a car accident. One was killed instantly, the other, Juan, was badly injured. We visited their home in the village of Alonso Yanez and gathered in a small room while Ben held Juan's hand and prayed for the family. His wife, 3-year-old son, and mother were also present.

A Christmas party was held in Alonzo Yanez on Wednesday evening! The children broke piñatas filled with candy and trinkets, received toys and bags filled with treats. Everyone feasted on pozole, tamales, buñuelos, and hot Christmas punch. Many new families attended and heard the Christmas story retold through the eyes of a shepherd. The Robinsons shared their musical talent and sang several Christmas songs for the whole group. All six of the missionaries helped each of the attendees create a beaded necklace while telling the story of salvation.

It is always such a blessing to share the word of God and make new connections with fellow Christians. Even though we may not speak the same language, the common love of God always finds a way through verbal communication barriers.

Prayers were appreciated and felt as the group ministered!
