


















A Thank You Message from Larry Danks

Our work begins with prayer, then we wash vases, fill them with water and take the bouguet apart to make individual arrangements. We are usually able to make seven arrangements from each arrangement. These arrangements are then delivered to members and friends in hospitals, nursing homes, and homebound. Some donors ask that we deliver to certain people and of course, we honor those requests. We pray again for the safety of those who drive to make these deliveries. The hardest part of our ministry is when we walk down the hallways of the nursing homes and people stop and ask if the flowers are for them. That is when we wish we had flowers for everyone!

We reached out to several nursing homes and asked about bringing whole bouquets to them, but some replied that residents sometimes associate bouquets with a death and would ask who died.

Our group has a great time of fellowship and we enjoy working together in this ministry. All are welcome and we would love for mothers and children, couples, and anyone else to join our ministry. We meet in room 121, 9 am, Monday mornings. If Monday is a holiday, we meet on Tuesday. The Flower Ministry is part of the Prime Time Ministries.

Standing Room Only (SRO) is a class of middle aged and older adults currently meeting in Room 134. Our name is derived from Ephesians 6:11 – "Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes." Our mission is equipping the saints with truths from God's Word through multiple interactive means.

The current course of study is the book of Revelation from the perspectives of several different writers (including the Apostle John). We are a smaller Bible study class that invites interaction and discussion with a focus on application of God's Word. Content varies from Bible book studies to video series and topical studies rather than a quarterly-based curriculum.

I have been teaching various ages of Bible study classes, including young marrieds, singles, high school, and all ages of adults, for over fifty years. I love to extract the richness of Scripture by focusing on the individual words of Scripture, exploring their meaning in the context of a specific passage, their meaning in their original language, and their meaning in the culture of the day in which they were penned.

We welcome all versions of Scripture, though we lean mostly on NIV and KJV. Past studies have included the writings and commentaries of such writers as J.D. Grear, Matt Chandler, Jennie Allen, Mark Batterson, Max Lucado, and Andy Stanley, as well as others.

Verse by verse studies have included 1st and 2nd Corinthians, Daniel, the Genesis story of Joseph, Mark, John, and selected Psalms.
